The space is bright with wide aisles, classic wood timbers, and an eclectic food hall that's home to 20 family owned restaurants with seating for over 300 guests, a two-story glass atrium, and an interactive Barnyard Kids play area. The Calgary Farmers' Market is an Alberta Approved Farmers' Market which means they strictly follow the 80/20 rule, where a minimum of 80% of their vendors need to "make it, bake it or grow it." This makes a huge difference in assuring that the Market caters to vendors who are producing products locally.


